

**THE "FIXED" 70x7 years - רתחנ - מיעבש מיעבש [Daniel 9:24]**

In BC 464 - The next in line for the throne, Artaxerxes, slaughtered Artabanus in a fight, restoring the Achaemenid dynasty. Artaxerxes' years count from the latter half of the year BC 464 (not BC 465), so his seventh year was during BC 458 to 457.

**The 490 years were "determined/fixed." So each year followed directly after the previous year. There were no gaps in the 490 years.**

**\*2 Autumn BC 5: The Lord Jesus was born. #**

**\*3 Autumn AD 26: The 30th Jubilee began. The Lord Jesus was baptised and anointed The Messiah by the Holy Spirit. #**  
**He fulfilled Isaiah 61:1 [Luke 4:17-21]. The seven years began in which the New Covenant was "confirmed" [Daniel 9:27].**

**\*4 Spring AD 30: The Lord Jesus was executed in the "midst" of the seven years in which the New Covenant was "confirmed."#**

**\*5 Autumn AD 33: The baptism of first Gentiles completed the seven years in which the New Covenant was "confirmed" [Acts 10 & 11].#**

**Cornelius' conversion was not long after 'the day of Pentecost.'**  
 The precise day and month in which "the going forth/issue/despach [MOTSA] of the decree to restore and build Jerusalem" is elusive. However the agreement in the timing of the years that secular history provides for:  
 1) the year in which Artaxerxes issued the decree, and  
 2) the birth, baptism and crucifixion of the Lord Jesus,# is too astounding to be mere coincidence.
