The Passover lamb was selected on the 10th. day of ABIB
The 14th was the LORD's Passover
Exodus 12:3,6,11



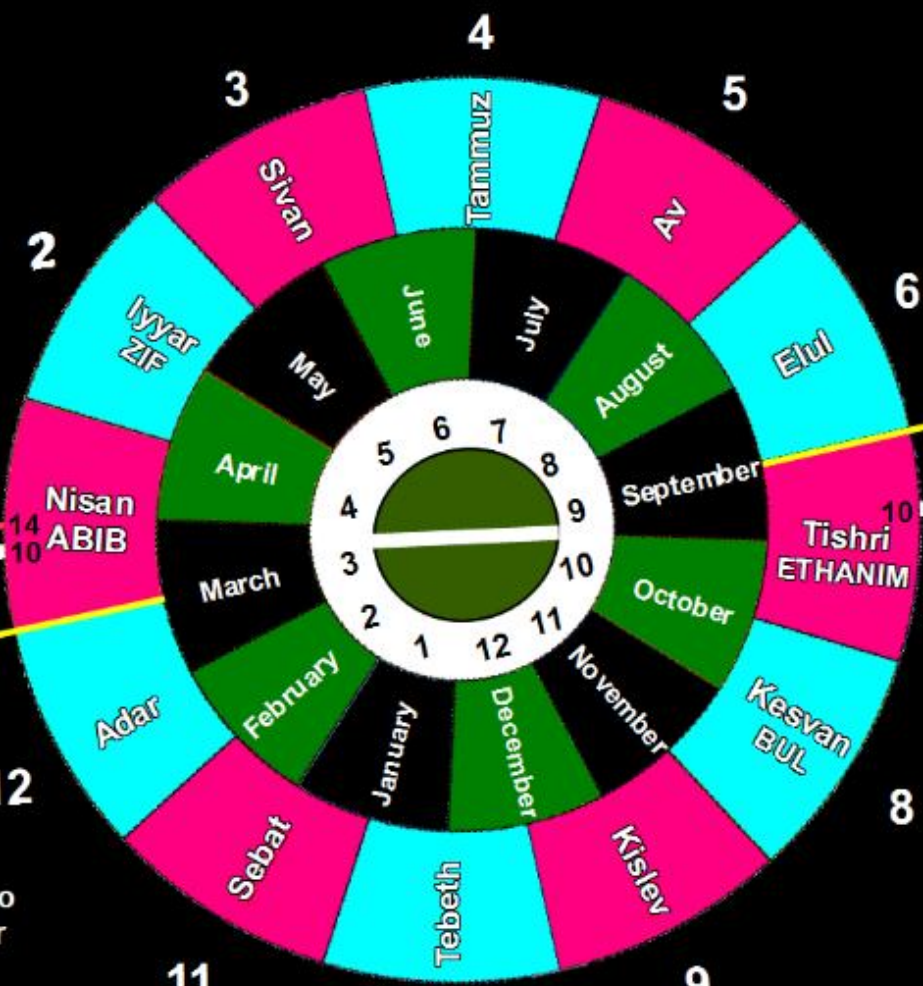
The 1st. day of Tishri was the Feast of Trumpets
Leviticus 23:24

The 10th. day of Tishri was The Day of Atonement
Leviticus 23:27

* Jubilees began on the 10th. day of Tishri each 7th. Sabbatical year and were to be regarded as a 50th. year
Leviticus 25:8-11

ABIB, also called Nisan, was the first month of the year
Exodus 12:2, 13:4

* Every 7th year was to be a Sabbatical year
Leviticus 25:2-4,
Joshua 4:19
(in Abib, see 5:10).
