

THE HEBREW - CALENDAR -

The 15th. to the 21st. days of ABIB was the Feast of Weeks. Leviticus 23:15-22

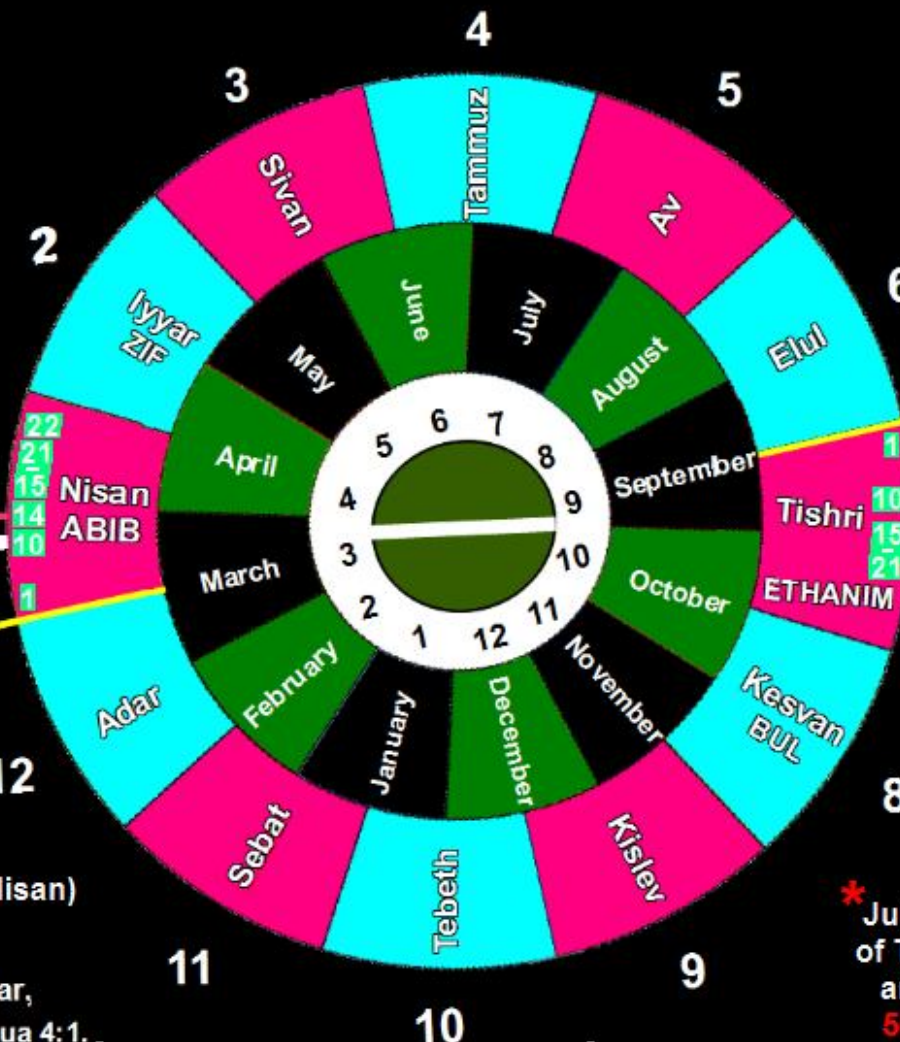
The 14th. of ABIB was The LORD's Passover. Exodus 12:3.6.11

The lamb was selected on the 10th.

ABIB, also called Nisan, was the first month of the year Exodus 12:2, 13:4

Months are always numbered from ABIB (Nisan) Numbers 28:16, Ezekiel 45:21

* Every 7th year was to be a Sabbatical year, beginning in Abib. Leviticus 25:2-4, Joshua 4:1.



The 1st. day of Tishri was the Feast of Trumpets Leviticus 23:24



The 10th. day of Tishri was the Day of Atonement Leviticus 23:27

The 15th. to 21st. days of Tisri was the Feast of Tabernacles Leviticus 23:33-43

* Jubilees began on the 10th. day of Tisri each 7th. Sabbatical year and were to be regarded as a 50th. Year. Leviticus 25:8-11.
